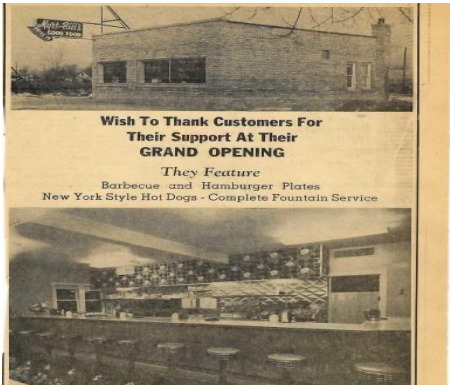
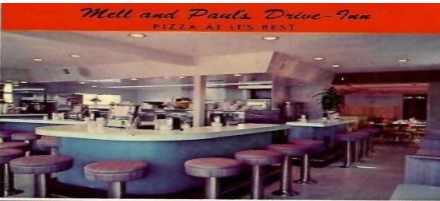




There is a lot of history here...

Trezeros Kitchen + Tap has been the home to many favorite Mount Prospect restaurants in its history.

Myrt and Bill's drive-in lunch wagon opened in 1948 on the corner of Northwest Highway and Central Road. Their hamburgers and New York hot dogs became so popular that by 1950 the owners opened a permanent structure restaurant at 302 W. Northwest Highway. Shortly after opening, they sold the restaurant to Paul and Carmella Caltagirone, who changed the name of the restaurant to Mell and Paul's Drive-In. The Caltagirones owned the restaurant until 1962, when they sold the building to Bill Golden. Golden's new restaurant, Golden Isle Restaurant and Catering Service, specialized in pizza and also featured "Mr. G's Room," a cocktail lounge. Golden Isle Restaurant closed in early 1965 and shortly after Jake's Pizza occupied the building, along with the Fountain de Bleu Room. Jake's Pizza stayed open until 2013. Trezeros Kitchen + Tap took over in 2016 and has called 302 W. Northwest Highway its home ever since.
